

## County Attorney Traffic Safety Program

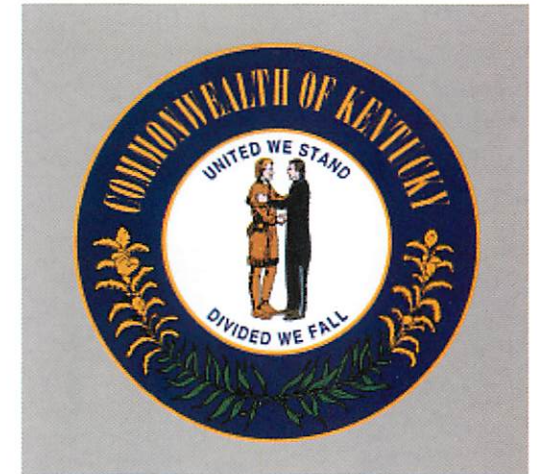
The County Attorney Traffic Safety (CATS) Program is an optional diversion program for traffic citations. It allows participants an opportunity to have their traffic citations dismissed without the violation showing up on their driving record or points added to their drivers license.

To complete the CATS Program, a participant must register, pay a \$170 administrative fee and complete a one hour online course. After completing the course, the County Attorney's office will dismiss the citation.

After registering for the CATS Program, a participant has 60 Days to complete the course.

### How to Sign Up

To register for the CATS Program, please complete the registration form and either mail it to 330 York Street, 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor, Newport, Kentucky 41071, fax a copy of the form to (859) 581-8304, or scan and e-mail it to [CountyAttorney@campbellcountky.gov](mailto:CountyAttorney@campbellcountky.gov).

After registering for the course, you will receive a letter and email containing your username and password for online access to the course where you will then be able to pay for and take the course.



Traffic citations eligible for the CATS program include:

- Speeding
- Disregarding a Traffic Control Device
- Disregarding a Stop Sign
- Loud Exhaust Violation
- Failure to Illuminate Headlamps
- Improper Equipment
- Failure to use Child Restraint Device
- Failure to or Improper Signal
- Improper Passing
- Careless/Reckless Operation of a Motor Vehicle
- Failure to Give Right of Way to Emergency Stopped Vehicle.



YOU MAY NOT BE ELIGIBLE FOR THE CATS PROGRAM IF YOU HAVE:

- Already paid your ticket,
- Signed up for State Traffic School,
- A Kentucky Commercial Drivers License,
- Taken the program in the last year, or
- Received a citation on the AA Highway for speeding 26 MPH or over, Careless or Reckless Driving

If you have questions about your eligibility for the CATS Program, call (859) 581-8015.

The CATS Program is optional, and you have the right to plead “not guilty” to the charge(s) against you, the right to a speedy trial, and all other guaranteed constitutional rights if you choose not to enter the CATS Program.

-The County Attorney reserves the right to deny any person the opportunity to participate in the CATS Program.
